Instructions for Adjusting the Incine of Your Amby

Assemble your Amby per instructions inside box.

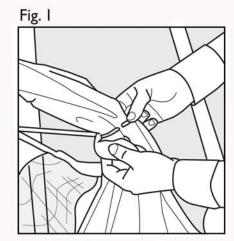
STEP I: Until your bows and take all the fabric out of the "horns" on the side of the coat hanger. See Fig. I

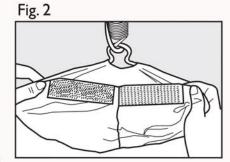
STEP 2: Next locate the Velcro strips on the front and back end of the hammock hanger. See Fig. 2

STEP 3: Cinch the Velcro strips together as shown in the photo. The head side Velcro will raise head side the more you cinch. If you want to lower head side undo Velcro as show in step 3. See Fig. 3

STEP 4: Retie bows.

STEP 5: If you find your baby is sliding toward the front (foot) end of the hammock you can repeat the same steps to raise the feet side by cinching the front Velcro. The goal is to create a "bowl effect" where your baby sleeps in the position where the feet are slightly elevated to reduce sliding forward.



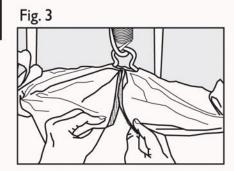


Baby Positioning

STEP I: If you want your baby's head to be raised higher, position the baby's feet closest to the zipper (front end) of the hammock. This will displace the baby's weight and will raise the head side.

STEP 2: Normal positioning is to place baby's "navel" or mid section "perpendicular" to the cross bar inside the hammock. The mid section should be placed in the middle of the hammock bed.

STEP 3: If you want the head side to be lower, position the baby's mid section further towards the head or back end of the hammock. This will displace the baby's weight more evenly.



Baby Gaining Weight

As your baby gains weight you might be required to "adjust the hammock head side lower" since your baby will be sinking into the hammock more because he will be gaining weight as he grows.
